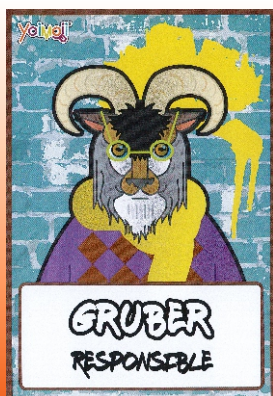


Class News from Oaks Class
