The staggered starts and finishes to the school day have helped to relieve some of the congestion in the car park at these times. We would therefore like to continue in September with a slightly less staggered start. School transport will arrive as normal but please can parents / carers dropping and picking up pupils arrive at 9am and collect at 3.10 from the various collection points.

There may be other changes and areas that need new risk assessments once there is more guidance about how school will look in September and I will endeavour to keep you informed of these.

If your child is requiring school uniform for September please contact Helene on reception who will be happy to help. Please can you make sure that your child has the correct PE uniform. For reasons of hygiene and safety, all pupils will need to change for PE lessons, including rebound therapy, into plimsolls or trainers with a white sole, a school house tee shirt and black shorts or tracksuit. The colour that your child's name is in on the class list refers to the house that they are in and the colour PE top that they need. Red for Ruby, blue for Sapphire and green for Emerald. Please can you also provide a labelled, drawstring PE bag, thank you.

I hope that many of you have been taking part in our sports day activities either at home or at school. I am looking forward to seeing what everyone has been up to.
