Aaron, Pilots: Excellent engagement and work in phonics group.

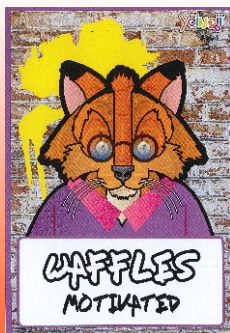
Anthony, Balloonists: Great writing and drawing.
