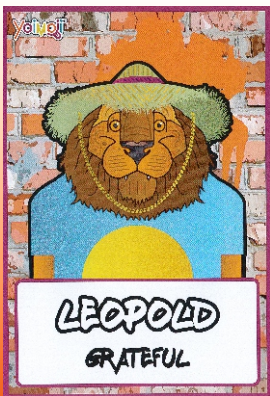


Class News from Cedar Class
