**Yochannan Cedar** - Being amazing in yoga & being calm and happy with transitions.

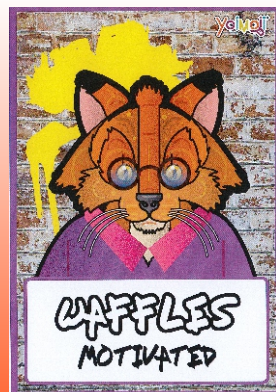
**William, Cedar** - Working so hard in all lessons.
