I'm in charge of what I do. When I take on a task, it's up to me to do well and people can trust me.



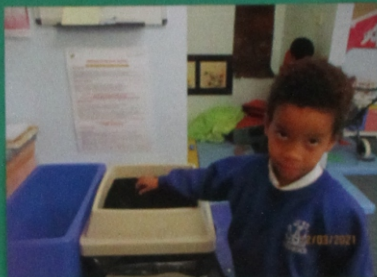
Jamie and Oliver offered to take the plates back to the kitchen.



Ella got on with the washing up without being asked.



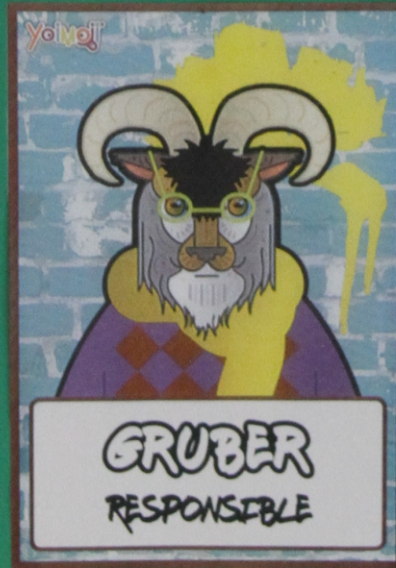
Zach has been responsible this week. He cleared up his own food rubbish after snack time without being prompted.
