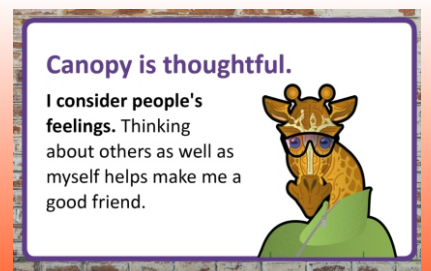

Class News from Trailblazers Class

Trailblazers topic this term is Frozen Kingdom, we have been learning about The Arctic and Antarctica, comparing the different places and considering how we could survive in the freezing conditions. This week the students worked together in groups to create survival shelters like Ernest Shackleton and his team of explorers had to do when they were stranded in Antarctica for 2 years. The students used blankets and resources they could find in the classroom and made some fantastic and creative shelters, they then enjoyed chilling out together inside them.

Other students in the class have also been focusing on the topic in their Sensory Drama sessions, they are working on a story called 'Mammoth, big beast, big city, big trouble.' In the story this week the character had had his hopes raised and dashed and the students explored a balloon inflating and deflating to represent this. He was also very useful cutting hedges, linking with this the students cut out pictures of elephants to practise this skill and then he spruced up so the students explored brushing their hair and wearing a tie.
