Zack, Trailblazers: A fantastic well written story using lots of descriptive words.

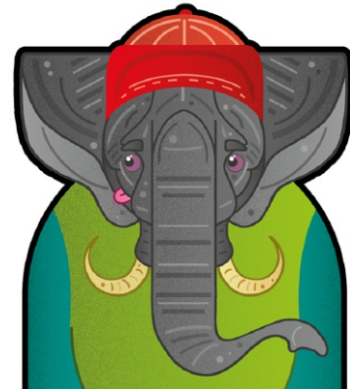
Yoimoji of the Week: Ferris
