Summer, Pilots - Going home and finding out why thunder is loud.

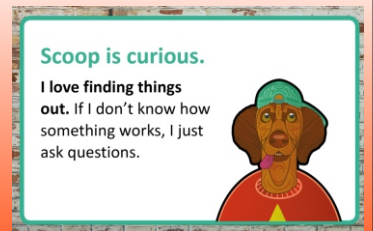
Jamie, Trailblazers - Finding out why thunder is loud and coming back the next day with the answer.
