Our Curriculum

We have a spiral curriculum

Knowledge and skills are revisited throughout a child's time at the school.

Knowledge leads to skills

We re-cap and re-visit knowledge so that it goes from short term to long term memory.

Our curriculum builds on knowledge, skills and vocabulary which progress through the school.

How it works at QEII

Our curriculum is pupil centred. Every child's physical, social and emotional well-being as well as their relationships with peers and trusted adults are extremely important and all staff know our pupils exceedingly well and are constantly building on these relationships and developing their understanding of their individual needs.

We use **cornerstones** to organise our curriculum and ensure that it is a broad and balanced curriculum. We also use EYFS and some subjects use other curriculums eg Maths, RE, PSHE, Drama

It has repeated themes and concepts which run through it.

As a special school we have significantly adjusted it and create our own specialist planning in which the skills and knowledge are bespoke to our pupils and tailored to their own learning and development.

We have devised our own assessment system, **Q levels**, to ensure it is a pupil centred curriculum and to assess progress using the **Earwig** platform.

Cornerstones long term plans are adapted to shorter term planning to meet the needs of individual pupils as identified for each of them in Earwig.

Pupil Centred Groups

Our pupils learn in different ways so we plan for three pathways **Explorers**, (informal learners) **Investigators** (semi formal learners) and **Engineers** (formal learners) starting with an initial hook and using adaptive teaching. However, it is never limited to these three pathways and within these, pupils Q levels break it down further making it individualised. The learning needs of pupils are met effectively through enabling and extending the learning and pathways are always fluid. Pupils move between pathways depending on their individual abilities and needs. Lessons for each of the pathways may take place in the classroom or in other rooms such as in Phonics and Maths.

E-Schools

You will also receive an E-Schools log in. Here you can see your child's class home page. You will also find your child's timetable, class information and details about the topic they are investigating during the term.

Here you can also have a conversation online with your child's teacher. As well as sharing with you what the class have been doing in school, they can also give you more personal information about what your child has been doing.
